Position Description: The role of the Technical Director is to provide leadership and strategic direction to support the technical development and quality of programming by overseeing the organization of all technical programs and technical staff (paid and volunteer).

Working Environment and Hours: A portion of the work week would be spent in an office environment, liaising and planning with administrative staff. Will also include evenings and weekends (as required), which would include some travel requirements

Salary: This is a full-time (40 hours/week) managerial/technical position which is salaried and not eligible for overtime. The salary will be reflective of experience and fit. A competitive mileage rate will be paid for any travel.

 - Supports the implementation of the Canada Soccer Grassroots Standards
- Partnerships
 - External representation of the club in all technical matters with Soccer Nova Scotia or the South Shore District Soccer Association and its member clubs.
 - Organize and participate in events that promote the club's values and increase community involvement.
 - Provide session planning and coach development opportunities for South Shore District Soccer Association coaches as required.
